**Materials List: Classical Drawing I, II\*\*, III & Drawing the Classical Figure I, II, III\*\***

For each course participant:\*

An easel for each course participant, one that can stand perpendicular to the floor.

Masonite drawing board, such as Dick Blick’s Sketch Board, H22945-1002, 23.5 x 26 in.

Simple mechanical #2 pencils, such as PaperMate Sharpwriter (available inexpensively in packages of 5 at Stop and Shop).

Kneadable eraser.

Drafting tape and masking tape.

Pad(s) of drawing paper, medium weight with some tooth (somewhat rough surface), off white or cream---not pure white, not bright white, 14 x 17 inch size.

Recommend Strathmore 400 Series Drawing Paper, in 14 x 17 inch size pad if available, or Canson Classic Cream Drawing 14 x 17 inch pad. (A pad could be shared by several course participants.)

Pad(s) of sketch quality paper, for quick studies. Off white or cream, not pure white, not bright white, 14 x 17 inch size ideally (can be 11 x 14).

Recommend Canson Universal Recycled Sketch if available, or Canson Heavyweight Sketch pad 14 x 17 inch (H10322-1007 in Dick Blick) or Strathmore Premium Recycled Sketch 14 x 17 (H10324-1007 in Dick Blick). (A pad could be shared by several course participants.)

Optional but desirable: a small sketch book that can be carried everywhere.

Optional but useful: a Mahl Stick, or something similar.

\*These materials are generally available through Dick Blick catalogue, 1-800-828-4548 or DickBlick.com, and also available at Cape Cod Photo and Art in Orleans. Cape Cod Photo and Art offers a 10% discount to students, mention that Kathryn Dana Halpern is the course instructor.

Regarding drawing pads available at Cape Cod Photo and Art: they carry Canson Classic Cream Drawing, also Classic Green. Get 14 x 17 inch size.

They also carry a Universal Sketch Pad, 65 lbs weight, best in 14 x 17 inch size, can be 11 x 14 inch.

\*\*Please note that for Classical Drawing II, and Drawing the Classical Figure II and III, some additional materials may be specified prior to class: e.g., Conte and white chalk, toned paper, and other items.
